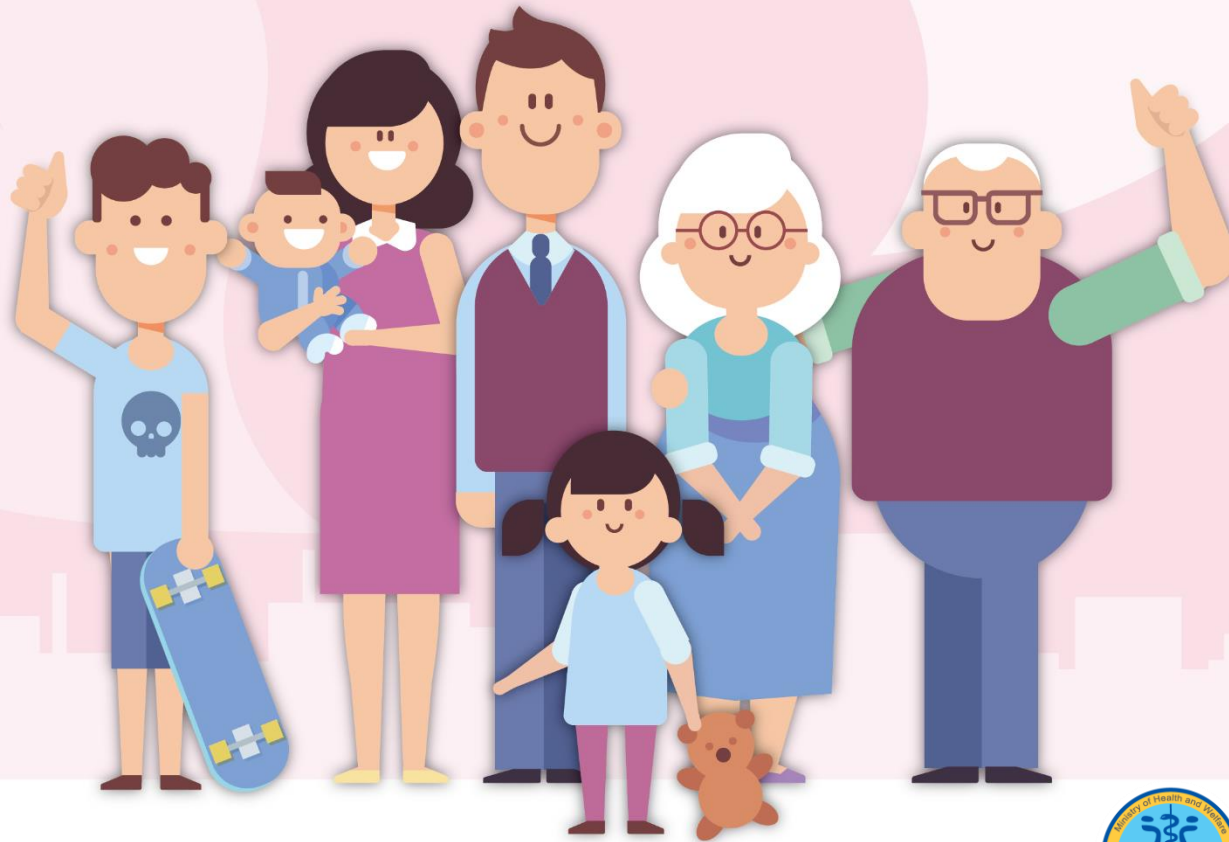

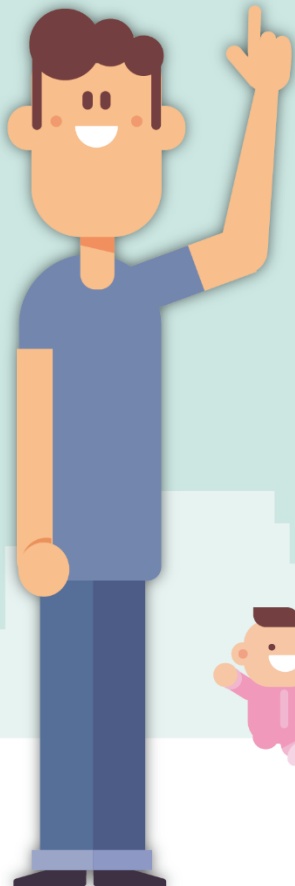

Investing in Children's Health

Upgrade Vaccination Policies

- ✓ The hepatitis A vaccination has been made available to children for free since 2018.
- ✓ Currently, our national immunization program for children includes 10 vaccines which can prevent 15 diseases.
- ✓ Children and the elderly who receive public vaccination injection have been no need to pay for diagnostic fee from 2018.

Taiwan's immunization coverage of children under 3 years old reached 94.7%.

The seventh-grade girls are granted to receive the HPV vaccines.

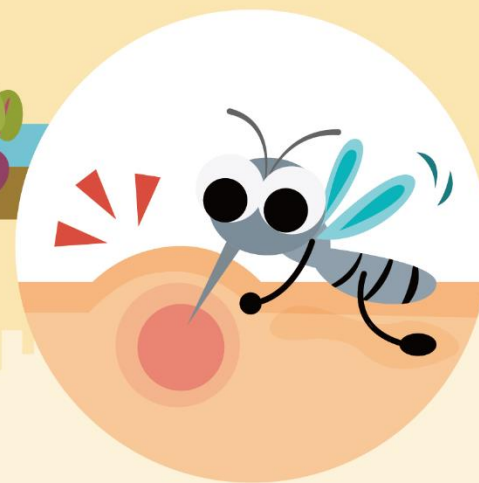
Reducing Impact Of Flu



- Extending the target population of the government-funded influenza vaccine and antivirals.
- Initiating 5 new prevent policies.
- These measures have led to significantly higher vaccination rates, as well as to fewer influenza deaths and serious complications.

The Fight Against Dengue

- The MOHW launches control project in the beginning of the year including enhancing management of high risk fields and strengthening the rapid detection system.
- These measures have helped to reduce dengue incidence significantly , and there were no dengue-related deaths in 2018.



Cherishing Medical Resources

- There are 41 Critical First Aid Responsibility Hospitals all over Taiwan.
- We subsidize existing establishments and develop regional mutual aid system to help the counties without Critical First Aid Responsibility Hospital reach emergency medical competency .

Emergency Medical Network



- We implement hierarchically integrated health policies including enhancing the capability of primary care service and promote two-way referrals.

Hierarchically Integrated Health Policy

- Guide the public's medical habits:
 - My Health Bank provides individual medical data.
 - Adjusting copayment



Healthy Lifestyle

Expand non-smoking environment and provide accessible smoking cessation service.

Tobacco



Taiwan's smoking rate and obesity rate decrease continuously, and the five-year survival rate for all cancers have increased 9.7%.

Nutrition



Established 22 local nutrition centers to improve citizens' nutrition condition.

Exercise



Train exercise and health teachers and promote exercise classes.

Cancer Screening



Perform 4 cancer screening including breast cancer, cervical cancer, colorectal cancer, and oral cancer.

Prevent overweight and obesity.



The Patient Autonomy Act

- ❑ This act went effect in January 2019. Taiwan is the first country to enact the specific law for patient autonomy in Asia.
- ❑ By May 2019, there are 97 medical institutions which can provide Advanced Care Planning in Taiwan.

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Eliminating Health Inequality

Aboriginal Area and Offshore Island Care Policy

2018-2020 Hometown and Offshore Districts Action Plan focus on strengthening local care supplemented by emergency air medical transportation.



Dedicated to Rural Medical Services

We strengthen emergency medical service provision by establishing permanent medical facilities remote areas.

Telemedicine

Telemedicine outpatient service help people in remote areas access services provided by a medical center physician.



Aboriginal Area Hepatitis C Elimination Program

We enforce a pilot plan in 4 townships.

Nurses

We promoted the mechanism of NHI linking to nurse–patient ratios and legalization, and established a platform for anonymous dispute reporting.

Doctors

The guideline for working hours of medical residents was implemented. And the Labor Standards Act will be applicable to medical residents as of September 1, 2019.

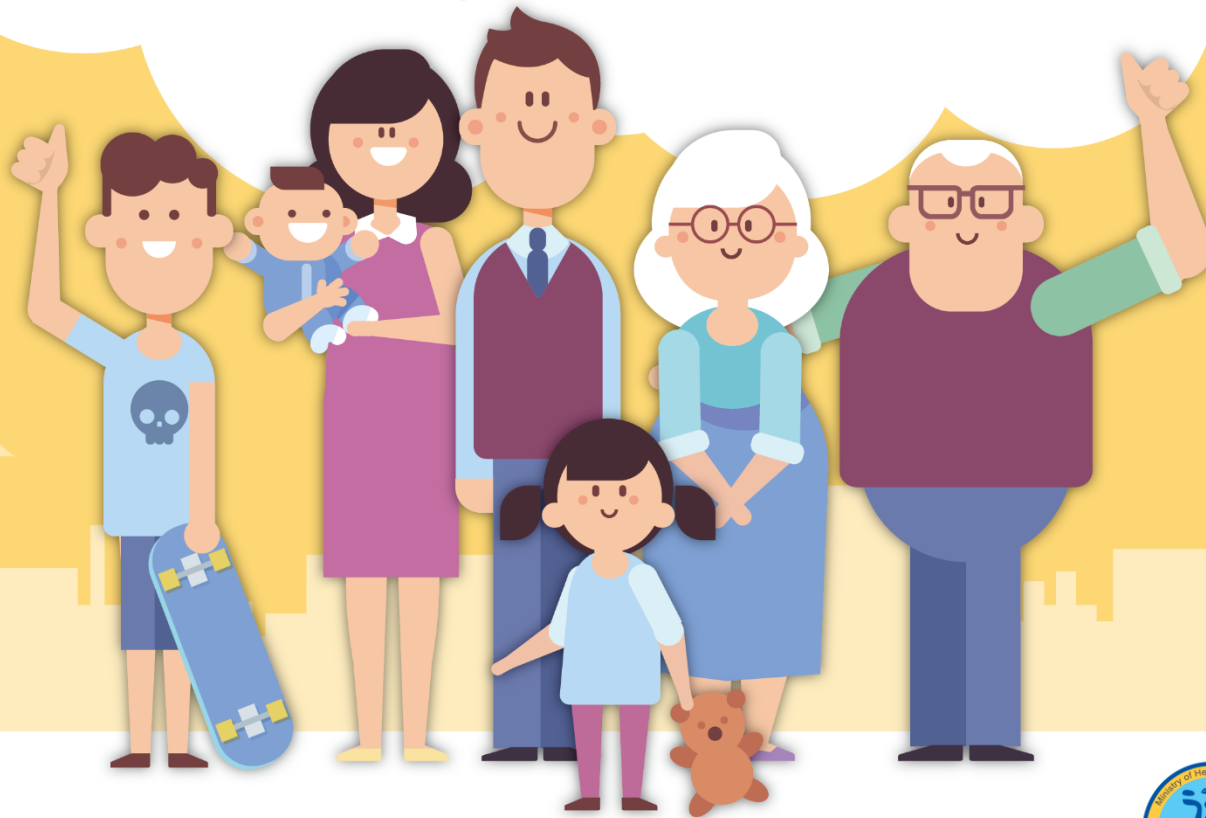
