

# **Sanitation Standard for Disposable Chopsticks**

DOH Food No. 0960404397 Announced, 06/29/2007  
MOHW Food No. 1021350146 Amended, 08/20/2013

## **Article 1**

This Standard is prescribed in accordance with the provisions of Article 17 of the Act Governing Food Sanitation.

## **Article 2**

The disposable chopsticks referred in this standard are those chopsticks made from bamboo or wood, intended for direct usage without washing or rinsing, and shall not be re-used.

## **Article 3**

No discoloration, off odor and flavor, contamination, mould, pest diseases, foreign matter or fibre fall off shall be found in disposable chopsticks.

## **Article 4**

The sulphur dioxide residue of the disposable chopsticks shall not exceed 500 ppm.

## **Article 5**

Hydrogen peroxide and diphenol shall not be detected in the disposable chopsticks.

## **Article 6**

This Standard shall be implemented from December 1, 2007.

The amended articles hereof shall come into effect as of the day of promulgation.
